## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

**1. Can I select more than one working topic for the application?**

*You can select only one working topic for the application. However, you can add relevant subtopics from other remaining topics as per LFS II 4th Cycle call guideline when you develop your activities.*

**2. Can I submit more than one initial proposal for this Call?**

*Eligible Indigenous Women's or Indigenous Peoples' organizations can submit only one application responding to this call.*

**3. Does the fiscal sponsor organization need to be Indigenous Women or Indigenous Peoples' organization or network?**

*Fiscal sponsor organization, if meets the eligibility outlined in LFS II 4th Cycle call, need not be Indigenous Women's or Indigenous Peoples' organization or network, but will need to provide a written collaboration agreement with the Indigenous Women organization to sponsor.*

**4. I am FIMI's AYNi partner organization. I have received AYNi funds in the past. Can I apply for this call again?**

*If your organization had a partnership with FIMI's AYNi fund in the past, you are eligible for the application.*

**5. I have received funds from a) the LFS Program implemented by another fund b) FIMI's Ayni Fund. Can I apply for this call again?**

*If your agreement contract is active with LFS program implementation by other funds or other FIMI's AYNi Fund program, you can't apply for this call.*

**6. I am applying for this call through my own organization. Can I be a consortium member for another application?**

*You can submit one application only either by own or in a consortium.*

**7. Who can be an established Indigenous Women's or Indigenous Peoples' organization?**

*Indigenous Women's or Indigenous Peoples' organizations at any level recognized nationally/ regionally and/or had successful partnership with FIMI at any point of time shall be considered as established Indigenous Women's or Indigenous Peoples' organizations.*

**8. What should a reference letter include?**

**The reference letter shall include-**

- a) write up testimony of being Indigenous Women's or Indigenous Peoples' organization or network and that Indigenous Women hold relevant positions in management and are the decision-makers;*
- b) Name, position and contact details (address, email, telephone no and other alternative means of communications- whatsapp, skype etc) of the responsible person and organization*

**9. What kind of cost can be included in 'total projected co-investment'?**

*The projected co-investment is reflected in everything that the community, organization or collective can contribute to the execution of the project, such as (but not limited to) languages, spirituality, technical resources, community resources (knowledge, time, space, etc.) to achieve a collective objective. They can also be monetary resources. Hence, it can be both in-kind and financial resources.*

**10. I am trying to upload a file but encountered a problem or I uploaded/ sent the wrong file. What shall I do?**

**11. My organization is not Indigenous Women's organization but works for Indigenous Women? Am I eligible to apply?**

*Only Indigenous Women's and Indigenous Peoples' organizations are eligible for this call. For details, please refer to LFS II 4th cycle call guideline.*
